(e) As previously disclosed in the Current Report on Form 8-K filed by Crown Castle Inc. ("Company") with the Securities and Exchange Commission on August 4, 2023, Catherine Piche has resigned and ceased serving as the Company's Executive Vice President and Chief Operating Officer-Towers effective September 30, 2023. In connection with the comprehensive resolution of all claims, if any, between the Company and Ms. Piche, the parties entered into a Separation and Release Agreement ("Separation Agreement"), dated October 6, 2023, which provides that Ms. Piche will receive, in exchange for her compliance with the Separation Agreement, the following payments and benefits: (1) continued base salary payments and continued Company subsidization of the cost of healthcare benefits, in each case, through the end of calendar year 2023 and (2) the opportunity for certain time- and performance-based restricted stock units previously granted to Ms. Piche to continue vesting until September 30, 2024, subject to the terms and conditions of the applicable award agreements, other than any employment condition.
